

RIBBONS & AWARDS

Ribbons will be awarded for First, Second, Third & Fourth in each height class for each level.

High in Class Ribbon for the dog which achieves a qualifying score and the fastest time in each class. Qualifying Ribbon for each dog achieving a qualifying score.

New Title Ribbon for the dogs who achieve a New Title during this event.

There will be Special items for dogs achieving RATM and RATCH.

Awards unclaimed more than 30 minutes after the last Trial on Sunday, January 8th, will be deemed as donated back to the club. No awards will be mailed!

RUNNING ORDER

Dogs will be run in any height order with dogs being handled by the same person separated into different staged groups.

It is the responsibility of the handler to be present for their class.

We will not track you down in your car, please be ready when your blind is called.

We will have 2 rings.

Dogs must have a Barn Hunt registration number before sending in entry.

Dogs may enter both the Instinct Test and Novice class in the same trial *until the dog has earned the RATN title and then they cannot enter the Instinct Test.*

Move-ups for the next day will be accepted up until 1/2 hour after the last Trial each day.

Move-up forms will be available at the Secretary's table.

All entries must be accompanied by entry fees to be valid.

A returned check does not constitute a valid entry.

There will be a \$50 fee for all returned checks.

USPS mailed entries make checks payable to Pacific NW Barn Hunt.

EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

All Barn Hunt rules & regulations apply on BHA event site. Barn Hunt site is defined by the area of the 4H Barn, crating area within 20 ft of the 4H Barn and the Restrooms closest to the 4H Barn.

- 1.) Please check-in without your dog.
- 2.) You can crate in your car or crating area will be available.
- 3.) It can be quite cold, please dress accordingly.
- 4.) It is YOUR responsibility to be familiar with Barn Hunt rules & regulations. You can review them at www.barnhunt.com
- 5.) PLEASE pick up after your dog!

Blinds will be 12 X 24 to provide ample room for all size dogs.

Please bring weather appropriate gear. These trials will be held in an enclosed barn, however it CAN be drafty and cold. There will be crating space available or car crating. Please make sure your crate is secure as the dogs may be highly excited.

Well behaved children ARE welcome. However, children are to be supervised for their safety. The dogs can be highly excited in this environment and we want to ensure that everyone has a good experience, dogs and humans alike.

Bitches in season are eligible for entry but will be required to be kept separate from all other dogs and will be run at the end of their class/trial. Entry fees for bitches that come into season will be refunded until closing time of the trial if you wish to withdraw. After the trial closes, entry fees will not be refunded. If bringing a bitch in season, please inform the Trial Secretary prior to the start of your Trial and inform all exhibitors at the judge's briefing.

- 1.) LEGIBLY fill out Entry Form completely and sign it. You may either use the entry form in this premium or Barn Hunt Association, LLC's "Create Mail-In Entry". To be a valid entry, details such as dog name, height, owner name, etc. must match details on file with Barn Hunt EXACTLY.
- 2.) Put your entries and payment checks in the same envelope. Checks or entries that arrive "solo" shall be immediately returned, and are not valid entries.
