Parking will be available in the Fairgrounds by trial building.

Spectators may not be within 10 feet of other competitors, the judge, or RWs around the ring. The club will designate where spectators will be allowed and where they must stand. No touching the fence is allowed. Other than entrants and direct family/support of entrants, no general visitors/ spectators will be allowed during this time

Leash Handling per COVID rules All dogs must be on leash and under control while on trial grounds. Dogs MUST run "naked," without a collar/harness while in the ring. Collars/harnesses or leads which can be easily and quickly removed and replaced are strongly encouraged. Slip leads, limited slip martingale leads, and sighthound leads strongly encouraged. **No flexi-leads will be allowed.**

No fans allowed due to Covid

Crating: It is also advisable to bring a crate for your dog during times they may need to be left unattended. **Competitors are encouraged to crate out of cars when possible. Crating areas will be designated by the Club which can enforce distancing. Do not touch anyone else's chairs, crates, setups, or dogs**

Clean up after your dog(s): Please pick up after your dog and dispose of waste in appropriate containers in the area. Please be considerate about picking up after your dogs and leaving the grounds as you found them. Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement per BHA regulations.

Please bring adequate water for you and your dogs.

Food in individual servings will be available

Smoking is not allowed on the grounds. If you must smoke, you will need to do so inside your vehicle and dispose of the butts in the vehicle also.

DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE:

From the West take I90 to West Salem (going East) Exit 12 – When coming to the top of the ramp take right towards BP station, take another right onto County C, go until you come to County M then turn right. Cross over Hwy 16 and you will see the fairgrounds on the left.

From the West (going East) - Take Hwy 16 East to West Salem. At the stop light (Hwy M) turn left. You will see the fairgrounds on the left.

From the East - Take Hwy 16 West to West Salem. At the stop light (Hwy M) turn right. You will see the fairgrounds on the left.

Check In:

Day of Trail entries must be in at 3:00 pm Friday and 7:00 am Saturday and Sunday for first trial and 1 hour before the first dog is in the ring for trial 2 of each day

General Briefing written information will be sent with your entry confirmation. There will be no briefings during the trials per COVID rules.

Bitches in season are eligible for entry but will be required to be kept separate from all other dogs and will be run in panties at the end of their class/trial.

- Entry fees for bitches that come into season will be refunded until time of trial closing, if you choose to withdraw. After trial closes on May 7, 2018 entry fees for will not be refunded.
- If bringing a bitch in season, please inform the trial committee prior to the trial, and you must inform all exhibitors at the judge's briefing.

No refunds will be made after the closing date of these trials. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, entered wrong class or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Loud/Disruptive dogs

- Dogs that are loud and disruptive may be asked to locate away from the rings/crating area and/or staged away from the other dogs getting ready to compete.
- Any dog behaving in a threatening or aggressive manner toward another dog or a person may be dismissed from the trial, without benefit of refund, if justification is found to do so by the judge and/or trial committee.
- Terrier sparring is not allowed on the trial grounds.
- Any dog that is sick, injured or lame will be excused from the trial grounds.
- Please be considerate about picking up after your dogs and leaving the grounds as you found them. Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement per BHA regulations.

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. Rules can be found at <http://barnhunt.com>
