*Judges are limited to 8 hours of judging and a maximum run value, which will require this club to limit entries accordingly

On Friday the 11th, the facility will open at 5:30pm, check-in will start at 5:30pm, please check-in at least 15 minutes prior to your run. General briefing will be held at 5:40pm. This trial will start with the first dog entering the ring at 5:45pm on Friday April 11th- we will run in this order: Crazy 8s, Crazy 8s, Master.

On Saturday, the facility will open at 8:15am, check-ins will start at 8:15am, please check-in at least 15 minutes prior to your run. General briefing will be held at 8:25am. This trial will start with the first dog entering the ring at 8:30am on Saturday April 12th. The facility will close when the events are completed. April 12th will run in this order: Instinct, Novice, Novice, Crazy 8s, Open, Open, Senior, Senior, Master, Master.

On Sunday, the facility will open at 8:15am, check-ins will start at 8:15am, please check-in at least 15 minutes prior to your run. General briefing will be held at 8:25am. This trial will start with the first dog entering the ring at 8:30am on Sunday April 13th. The facility will close when the events are completed. April 13th will run in this order: Master, Master, Crazy 8s, Instinct, Novice, Novice, Senior, Senior, Open, Open.

Classes are consecutive.

A Barn Hunt Association Number is required to enter this trial.

This location is an outdoor facility at a private residence with limited parking, no overnight parking. Set ups allowed, but **MUST BE** taken down each night, <u>no items left overnight</u>. Dogs may be crated in vehicles and must be on lead at all times when not actively hunting. No wheelchair accessibility. Please park in the designated areas, we will include instructions in the confirmation email. We will have parking spots designated for volunteers. When you arrive, please go through the gate on the right side into the backyard.

The 3 rings are outdoors with grass or turfed ground that is covered with hay.

Blinds will be set up for the trial runs. Blinds will be 20 feet from the ring. The blinds will be 10'x20' in size to accommodate 4-6 dogs and handlers. Chairs will be provided in the blind.

If you would like to volunteer for this event, please contact Sara Shumway (702-488-1054). Volunteers will be given raffle tickets that can be used for prizes or future discounts on trials.

The running order will be posted near the blind. We reserve the right to change the run order if necessary.

- RUN ORDER: The club reserves the right to change the run order based on entries received and shall send the judging schedule prior to the start of the trial with confirmation. Dogs will be run in staged groups of no more than six (6) in Instinct, Novice, & Open, five (5) in Senior, and four (4) in Master. Dogs being handled by the same person will be separated into different staging groups (blinds).
- MOVE UPS: Previous trial move ups must be submitted by Noon, April 10th, 2025, via email. Same day move ups must be turned in to the Secretary no later than 30 minutes after the last class of the first trial of the day. Next day move ups must be submitted no later than 30 minutes after the last class of the day. Exhibitors may also request lateral and move downs.
- HEALTH/SAFETY: We will follow all local and state health & safety rules with information being sent out with your final confirmation as these rules can change quite frequently. If you are not able or willing to follow the local/state rules, please DO NOT enter this trial.
- COLLARS & LEADS: No electronic collars, bark collars, muzzles or head halters allowed on Barn Hunt show grounds. Per Barn Hunt Association all pinch collars must be covered. No retractable leashes or flexi leads to be used onsite.
- BITCHES IN SEASON (BIS): May compete but must be run at the end of each class. BIS must wear pants at all times when not in their vehicle except when being pottied in the designated BIS potty area. Please inform the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the trial so your fellow exhibitors can be made aware of BIS present.
- HEIGHT DIVISIONS: Small Dogs 15" and under at the withers, Medium Dogs 15.1" to 22" at withers, and Large Dogs over 22" at withers.
- DOG AGGRESSION: A judge or the trial committee may dismiss any dog behaving in a threatening or aggressive manner toward another dog or person. Please report any issues immediately.
- ANIMAL SAFETY: The safety of our dogs and rats are our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar and physically able to perform all course elements.
- AWARDS: Qualifying runs in Instinct receive a flat qualifying ribbon. Novice through Master qualifying runs receive a flat qualifying ribbon. Novice through Master placement ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th double flat. A team earning a new title shall receive a New Title Rosette. The Club awards High in Class Ribbons to the dog receiving the best score in Novice A, Open A, Senior A, Master and Championship Classes. The Club will also award High in Class Ribbon for B Classes with more than four competitors. If a competitor receives a RATCH, RATCHX or higher RATCH title at this trial, they will receive a special RATCH ribbon; we also award

Novice X through Senior X Titles ribbons. We have Crazy 8 rosettes available for those teams who earn their Bronze, Silver, Gold or Platinum Titles. ****If you anticipate achieving a RATCH or RATCHX+ or a Crazy 8s Title** please advise the trial chair (email or call/text) when you enter the trial.

- REFUNDS & CANCELLATION POLICY: After the closing date, entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the trial committee. Every attempt will be made to hold this event as scheduled. The club will refund all monies less what is needed to pay for unrecoverable costs if the event cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the event committee. Abuse of any kind toward volunteers, dogs, rats, competitors, grounds, judges, or the trial committee will not be tolerated and will result in immediate dismissal from the event with no refund.
- REFUNDS & CANCELLATION POLICY (continued): Withdrawals after the closing date due to an injury of the dog
 will receive a refund of paid entry fees. Request for a refund must be accompanied by a dated note from a
 veterinarian and must be emailed or mailed to the Trial Secretary. If you do not follow all health/safety rules as
 outlined by BHA, Smarty Paws Rat Pack BH, or local and state governments, you will be asked to leave the
 grounds immediately, for the weekend, and there will be no refund of your entry fees.
- RETURNED CHECKS: A returned check does not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$50 fee for all returned checks.
- SMOKING: Smoking and Vaping are not allowed on the property.
- FOOD: Bottled water and small snacks will be available for our volunteers.
- NO SITE CAMPING.
- GENERAL INFORMATION: Dogs must be eligible to run a class at time of entry. Dogs will be blinded in groups of four or five, no more than six. Dogs who complete a title at a trial may move up in the next trial. Please make move-up requests at the Trial Secretary's desk as soon as possible. Handlers are responsible for making the request in time for the move-up to be processed.
- Handlers who fail to pick up after their dogs may be excused from the trial.
- This event is for dogs over 6 months of age.

Entry Fees:

- Registration Opens March 1st, Registration Closes on March 29th.
- Instinct will be \$20 per run.
- Novice & Open will be \$25 per run.
- Senior, Master, and Crazy 8s will be \$30 per run.
- Late entries accepted until the trial is full, please add \$5 to each run.
- Move-ups during this trial.
- Withdrawals & Refunds must be requested by March 22nd.

Please use the entry form on the Barn Hunt Association's website, or use the attached entry form. Entries without signatures or payment will not be accepted. Please fill out your form correctly, any errors on the form will be the responsibility of the owner. You will receive a confirmation email for your entry.

All entries must be accompanied by correct entry fees. Entries must have a Barn Hunt Association registration number. Forms submitted without a registration number will be returned. Any entries received before the opening date or after the closing date will be returned. A returned check does not constitute a valid entry and will incur a \$50 penalty. Note: you may fill your entry form out online by clicking "Create/Modify Mail-in Entry Form" at the event link on barnhunt.com. Be sure to click the "I understand" box and print your entry (use the "print" button right under the box) before mailing it. A wait list will be maintained. Entrants who withdraw after the closing date will receive a refund only if there is an entrant on the wait list who can take their place.
