1st-4th placement ribbons will be awarded for all A & B classes. All A class placements will be by height (S,M,L) as will Master B. There are no placement ribbons for Crazy 8s.

High in Class ribbons will be awarded to the overall fastest dog for each A class and for Master B. This excludes Instinct and Crazy 8s.

New Title ribbons are available for all levels. including Instinct and Crazy 8s.
