This Trial will be held indoors in a building with concrete floors. There is plenty of crating available.

Open to all breeds and mixed breeds.

Dogs **MUST** to be registered with Barn Hunt to participate in this trial.

There will be a short lunch break at the judges' discretion.

Trial entry limits: Judges are limited to 8 hours of judging and a maximum run value (MRV 260), which will require this club to limit entries accordingly. Crazy 8s will be limited to 40 runs Saturday and Sunday. The limit may be raised and the class split with or moved to another ring depending on entry counts at closing.

Late and/or Day of Show entries are not a guaranteed entry and will be accepted only up to Judging limits. Confirmations will not be sent for late entries. This club **WILL** allow multiple entries per trial.

#### Pre-entry fees:

\$15 for Instinct; \$22 for Novice/Open; \$27 for Senior/Master/Championship; \$25 for Crazy 8, \$20 for Line Drive Entries received after early entry date & day of show entry fees: \$20 for Instinct; \$27 for Novice/Open; \$32 for Senior/Master/Championship; \$30 for Crazy 8s, \$20 for Line Drive

Registration opens July 7, 2025 at midnight. Entries at the above fees will be accepted in the order received until closing date of August 6, 2025, at 8:00 PM with the Trial Secretary or until the maximum entry limit is reached. If the trial does not fill with pre-entries, late entries will be accepted until limits are met. Entries post-marked after the closing date must pay late entry prices. If entering at trial, please come with a printed entry form and waiver filled out. A wait list will be maintained after the trial fills.

Trial to trial move-ups are allowed. Move-ups between A and B classes will be allowed.

Register your dog online at: www.barnhunt.com. Allow at least 48 hours to receive a Barn Hunt number. Handlers are responsible for entering and writing legibly the correct Barn Hunt number for their dog on entry form. An incorrect number may result in any legs earned being forfeited.

We are in Expo Hall A. This is the first building you drive past when entering from the Main Gate.

The final class order and further scheduling details will be emailed to all exhibitors no later than Monday, August 11, 2025, after the actual number of entries is known for each class. If you do not receive an email by Monday night, please contact the trial secretary. Dogs being handled by the same person will be separated into different staged groups.

In order to comply with the provisions of Wisconsin Statutes [s. 95.21 (2)] and Administrative Codes [s. ATCP 11.52], relating to the Statewide Rabies Control Program, the owner of any dog kept or exhibited in Wisconsin (other than a dog kept for educational or scientific purposes) shall have the dog vaccinated against rabies by a veterinarian at no later than 5 months of age and revaccinated within one year after the initial vaccination.

Any person (including out-of-state exhibitors) who imports a dog into Wisconsin (for exhibition or any other purpose) must have a valid interstate health certificate or certificate of veterinary inspection for that dog, regardless of the age of the dog. The certificate must be completed by a veterinarian; accompany the dog when it enters this state; and indicate the current vaccination status of the dog.

Vaccinations shall be administered by a veterinarian and comply with age and time standards and label instructions approved by the federal bureau for the type of vaccine used.

Additional information regarding these regulations may be obtained from the Wisconsin State Veterinarian at 608-224-4888.

"Dogs found in an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way (for example: left unattended on a grooming table in a noose not attached to a safety release clip; left in a vehicle without proper ventilation) will be removed to safety. Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way is considered mistreatment."

Sunday: Trial 3: Ring 1 (Sue Kendall): Instinct, Novice, Open, Senior

Ring 2 (Cathy Hoese): Master/Championship

Sunday: Trial 4: Ring 1 (Sue Kendall): Novice, Open, Senior, Line Drive Ring 2 (Cathy Hoese): Master/Championship, Crazy 8s

Classes in Ring 1 will be run concurrently! Instinct-Novice 1-Novice 2-Open 1-Open 2-Senior 1-Senior 2-Line Drive.

Classes in Ring 2 will be run Master 1-Master 2-Crazy 8s 2.

Judge of Record and Event Official dogs may be judged prior to Event start or as the first dogs of event.

#### **Exhibitor Information:**

All entries must be accompanied by entry fees to be valid. A returned check does not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$50.00 fee for all returned checks. Make check payable to Bales and Tails. Send entries & fees to the trial secretary: Brenda Hinkemeyer, 9841 – 58<sup>th</sup> Ave., Clear Lake, MN 55319.

There is **NO SMOKING or vaping** in this facility. If you must smoke, you will need to do so outside 20 feet away from the building and dispose of the butts accordingly. **Dogs must be ON LEASH at ALL times unless they are in the ring.** 

The safety of the rats and dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and / or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and / or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, may be asked to leave the site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

**Dog exercise areas:** Please pick up after your dog and dispose of waste in appropriate containers outside the building. Please be considerate about picking up after your dogs and leaving the grounds as you found them. Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement per BHA regulations.

**Collars and Leashes:** Dogs may not be brought to the line in any disallowed collar. Dogs may not be brought to the start box on flexi-leads. Approved collars include flat snap or buckle collars of solid construction and leather or nylon leads. Limited slip martingale collars are allowed. Single piece slip collars/leads are allowed. Harnesses, with the exception of head-halter types, are allowed. Dogs MUST run "naked," without a collar/harness. Dogs should be brought to the ring with collars/harnesses which can be easily and quickly removed and replaced. All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring.

**Withdrawal:** Entries may be withdrawn and fees refunded (see note on electronic payment) if Trial Secretary is notified in writing prior to the closing date. In writing is either by mail or email only. See refund policy for refunds after closing.

Refunds: Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee or BHA. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on entry forms; illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the trial. No refunds after the closing date unless a replacement entry is available from the wait list. If you become symptomatic with Covid after closing, and there is no waitlist run to replace your runs, you will get your entry fee credited toward a future trial minus \$1 per run administrative fee.

**Bitches in season** are eligible for entry but will be required to be kept separate from all other dogs and will be run in panties at the end of their class. Review the barn hunt rules for other details. *If bringing a bitch in season, please inform the trial committee prior to the trial, and you must inform all exhibitors at the judge's briefing.* 

**Loud/Disruptive dogs**; Dogs that are loud and disruptive may be asked to locate away from the rings/crating area and/or staged away from the other dogs getting ready to compete. Any dog behaving in a threatening or aggressive manner toward another dog or a person may be dismissed from the trial if justification is found to do so by the judge and/or trial committee. Terrier sparring is not allowed on trial grounds. Any dog that is sick, injured or lame will be excused from the trial grounds.

**Judging Assignments:** Any Judge of Record at this event may be used as a Load Balancing or Relief Judge in any ring, at the discretion of the Club, under the rule provisions for Load Balancing, Relief Judging, and Splitting. Qualifying scores are assigned to the official Judge of Record for that class.


**Conflicts:** These trials are held in conjunction with the Indianhead Kennel Club all breed shows. Every effort will be made to accommodate breed conflicts as long as we are informed in advance after ring times have been established. Rings will be held no longer than **10 minutes** after class judging is done. There are other events happening including dock diving and possibly FastCAT. Exhibitors must make arrangements with the trial secretary and get to a blind for their class in a timely manner.

Crating should be secure. Dogs can get excited at barn hunt events. Dogs must be securely crated at all times or with owner on a leash. Dogs may not be left unattended outside of a secure crate. We will have crating available in the building! You can also crate in your car. Be sure to prepare for heat.

**Blinds:** Blinds will be 10'x20' EZ Ups with sides for Ring 1 and Ring 2. They will be located in the building 15' from the ring. Blinds will have 5 dogs assigned per blind (6 will be assigned for Instinct/Novice/Open), but may be closed early, as allowed in the rules.

**Ring Equipment Damage:** If your dog intentionally damages any of the ring equipment, you will be charged for the repairs. This does not include bales and tubes (to the extent of the rules).

**Trial Location**: See the orange circled building. That is where the barn hunt will be held. The trial grounds consist of the building and the grassy areas around it. Also the overhang. Parking will be as directed by the kennel club. There may be a parking fee charged by that club.
