JUDGE: Rachel Corbett, BHAJ-286A, Huber Heights, Ohio will judge all classes. Pam Schairer, BHAJ-169A, Ostrander, Ohio will Relief/Back-Up Judge. Judges are limited to 8 hours of judging and a maximum run value, which will require this club to limit entries. Judge of Record and Event Official dogs may be judged before the official start time or as the first blind(s) of the event.

Saturday: Master 1-2, Senior 1-2, Crazy 8's 1-2, Open 1-2, Instinct 1, Novice 1-2

Sunday: Instinct 1, Novice 1-2, Open 1-2, Crazy 8's 1-2, Senior 1-2, Master 1-2

The club reserves the right to change the run order based on entries received.

ENTRIES: Registration opens on the date stated at the top of the premium. Early entries will be discarded. Entries are accepted based on the payment date. We will continue to accept entries until judging limits are met or until the closing date stated at the top of the premium. Late entries are accepted at no additional charge. Day of Show entries will not be accepted. Late entries will be taken from the closing date until the "Late entries accepted until" date stated at the top of the premium. Late entries are not a guaranteed entry and will be accepted only up to judging limits. Confirmations will not be sent for late entries. If the trial fills, a waitlist will be maintained. Email the Trial Secretary indicating you would like to be added to the waitlist. Double-entry per trial is not offered at this event. Exhibitors can only enter classes they are eligible for at the time of entry.

ENTRY FEES: Instinct, \$10; Novice, Open, \$20; Senior, Crazy 8's, & Master \$25.

ACCEPTED METHODS OF ENTRY/PAYMENT: You may enter by filling out and sending the form in this premium or the printed form on the Barn Hunt website, with a check payment to the Trial Secretary. If you use the form on the Barn Hunt website, you must print the form and send it in with a check. You may also enter online and pay electronically.

ELECTRONIC ENTRIES AND PAYMENT: We accept and encourage electronic entries and payments for this event. Electronic entries are via Jotform with payment via Paypal. A 3.5% + \$0.49 online entry processing fee will be added to electronic entries. To enter and pay electronically, use this link:

ENTRY COUPONS/VOUCHERS: Coupons won as raffle prizes and Blue Ribbon Vouchers (GCDOC members) can be used to reduce entry fees. If you are mailing your entry and wish to use coupons or vouchers, include them with your registration form along with payment (cash or check) for the remaining entry fee amount. If you are registering online through Jotform, you must text or email Rachel Corbett at 937-684-3870 or louie.and.ruth@gmail.com **prior to** submitting your entry online. Rachel will give you a discount code based on the number and value of the coupons and/or vouchers you plan to use. The discount code can then be entered into the Jotform to give you the correct amount owed via PayPal. **All coupons and/or vouchers redeemed in this manner must be physically given to the Trial Secretary upon your arrival to the event. Failure to do so may result in a forfeiture of your entries until payment is received.**

REFUNDS & CANCELLATION POLICY: After the closing date, entry fees will not be refunded if a person or dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the trial committee.

Every attempt will be made to hold the event as scheduled. In the event of an “Act of God” such as fire, flood, severe weather, etc., an event may be canceled. The Club must make every attempt to contact entrants and inform them of the cancellation. In such a case, the Club is not obligated to return any or all entry fees collected.

Abuse of any kind toward volunteers, dogs, rats, judges, other competitors, trial grounds, or the trial committee will not be tolerated and will result in immediate dismissal from the event with no refund.

Competitors who withdraw any or all entries from a trial or trials after the closing date receive a refund, minus processing fees, if there is a wait-listed entry to replace the withdrawn entry. If a person withdraws after the closing date and there is no waitlist, their entry is not eligible for refund.

Withdrawals after the closing date due to injury of the dog will receive a refund of paid entry, minus processing fees. Requests for a refund must be accompanied by a dated note from a veterinarian and must be emailed or mailed to the Trial Secretary before the close of the trial.

MOVE-UPS: Move-ups or move-downs will be accommodated when possible. Please contact the Trial Secretary as soon as possible if your dog titles at another event and you wish to move-up for this event. If moving from Open to Senior due to titling at another event, you will be responsible for the additional \$5 per trial entry fee. If move-up occurs during this event, there is no additional fee. Due to the Saturday run order, move-ups from Novice to Open, Open to Senior, and Senior to Master are not available.

ATTENDEES ALLOWED: Open to all breeds 6 months or older. Dogs must have a registration number with the Barn Hunt Association.

GROUND: The trial building is set on several acres. The land is completely fenced except for the front gate. Portable restrooms and running water are available. The entire property is grass with the exception of a gravel entryway. The grounds do get muddy when it rains, so please plan accordingly.

ACCESSIBILITY: The facility and grounds are handicapped accessible.

SMOKING: Smoking is not allowed except in your vehicle and 100' or more from any building or porta john.

TRIAL CONDITIONS: Trials will be run indoors in a climate-controlled building. There is a single ring with concrete floors covered with rubber matting. No indoor crating.

BLINDS: Covered, outdoor blind, 10'x20' or larger with dog separators will be utilized. No more than 5 or 6 dogs per blind.

CRATING: Dogs will be crated in vehicles or outdoors and must always be on a leash when not in the ring.

FOOD: There will be a potluck on both days. The Hospitality Coordinator will reach out to you via email prior to the trial with further details.

SCHEDULE:

7:30 am – Grounds open, Check-In

8:15 am – General briefing (both days) followed by Instinct briefing (Sunday only)

8:30 am – First blind loaded

Saturday Run Order: Master 1-2, Senior 1-2, Crazy 8's 1-2, Open 1-2, Instinct 1, Novice 1-2

Sunday Run Order: Instinct 1, Novice 1-2, Open 1-2, Crazy 8's 1-2, Senior 1-2, Master 1-2

Run order is subject to change.

Grounds close 30 minutes after the last dog runs.

COLLARS & LEADS: No electronic collars, bark collars, muzzles, or head halters are allowed on Barn Hunt show grounds. Per Barn Hunt Association rules, all pinch collars must be covered.

BITCHES IN SEASON (BIS): Bitches In Season may compete but must be run at the end of each class. BIS will be in their own blind unless all competitors in a given blind agree to allow a BIS in that blind. BIS must always wear pants when not in their vehicle or when being pottied in the designated BIS potty area. Please inform the Trial Secretary before the start of the trial so your fellow exhibitors can be made aware of a BIS' presence on trial grounds.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS: Small – Dogs 15" and under at withers, Medium – Dogs 15.1" to 22" at withers, and Large – Dogs over 22" at withers.

DOG AGGRESSION: A judge or the trial committee may dismiss any dog behaving in a threatening or aggressive manner toward another dog or person. Please report any issues immediately!

ANIMAL SAFETY: The safety of our dogs and rats is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and physically able to perform all course elements.

AWARDS: Awards are offered for placements, high in class, and new titles. The slowest qualifying dog in each class will get a turtle award.

DIRECTIONS:

From Cincinnati via I-75 N: Use the left two lanes to take Exit 54B for OH-4 N toward Springfield. Continue on OH-4 N for 1.5 miles. Take the Stanley Ave. North (Dayton Children's Hospital) exit. Merge onto Stanley Ave. North. At the third traffic light, make a right onto OH-201 N/Brandt Street. In 1 mile, turn right onto Valleycrest Dr. The Land is the first driveway on the left.

From Columbus via I-70 W: Take Exit 38 for OH-201 toward Huber Heights. Use the left lane to turn left onto OH-201 S/Brandt Street. Follow OH-201 S/Brandt Street for 6.3 miles. Turn left onto Valleycrest Dr. The Land is the first driveway on the left.

From Indianapolis via I-70 E: Take Exit 33A for I-75 S toward Dayton. Merge onto I-75 S and drive for 4.5 miles. Take Exit 56 for Stanley Ave. Turn left onto Stanley Ave. Head east on Stanley Ave. for 1.3 miles. Turn left onto OH-201 N/Brandt Street. In 1 mile, turn right onto Valleycrest Dr. The Land is the first driveway on the left.

From Toledo via I-75 S: Take Exit 56 for Stanley Ave. Turn left onto Stanley Ave. Head east on Stanley Ave. for 1.3 miles. Turn left onto OH-201 N/Brandt Street. In 1 mile, turn right onto Valleycrest Dr. The Land is the first driveway on the left.
