Saturday Trial 1 & Trial 2 will run concurrently

Instinct (ONLY in 1st Trial of the day), Novice, Novice, Open, Open, Senior, Senior, Master, Master

Sunday Trial 3 & Trial 4 will run concurrently

Master, Master, Senior, Senior, Open, Open, Instinct, Novice, Novice

Move Ups: **ON SATURDAY ONLY**

'B' CLASSES: offered If you have a RATM title then you are working toward RATCH and MUST be in the B class.

Each day: Small to Tall with accommodations made for handlers with multiple dogs
Judge will break for lunch at their own discretion.

Dogs are required to have a Barn Hunt Registration number to enter in Barn Hunt Trial. Register your dog online at: www.barnhunt.com

You can not submit an entry without a valid barn hunt number

CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY: The receipt of entries will be confirmed once your runs have been approved for those providing a return e-mail address on their form.

If you don't receive an email confirmation *before* closing date- email the trial secretary ASAP!

VALIDATION OF ENTRIES: Entries must be complete, accurate and legible with entry fees, and signed **WAIVER AND INDEMNITY**. Entries submitted without this agreement filled in and signed will be refused participation in the trials.

REFUND OF ENTRY FEES: Entries cancelled before closing date will be subject to a \$5 processing fee. Entry fees will not be refunded after the closing date in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee, except for bitches in heat and for injured dogs with vet proof. No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, and act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other causes beyond the control of the organizing committee.

MOVE UPS: THIS APPLIES TO SATURDAY TRIALS ONLY Dogs earning a title in one trial may be moved up to the next class for the second trial. This is up to the handler and not required. Move-ups will be accepted until 30 minutes before the start of each Trial. You must complete the Move-up form available at the secretary's table.

No moves up on Sunday

AWARDS: Q Ribbons will be awarded for all qualifiers in the regular classes (A & B) Dogs that earn a Barn Hunt title RATN or higher will receive a title rosette.

Rosette for 'Perfect Weekend' To be eligible, your dog must have qualified in all four trials in classes above Instinct. *It is your responsibility to notify the Trial Secretary if you are receiving this award.*

Placement ribbons will be awarded in "A" classes and in B classes as per the rules.

High in Class ribbons will be offered for "A" & "B" classes.

Special awards will be offered at this event for various categories.

TRIAL SITE: Trial will be held outdoors on grass/dirt with an outdoor covered staging area, which is wheelchair accessible. **A TENT will cover the ring area.**

Port-a-Potty will be on site, it is not wheelchair accessible.

Bring water, shade and shelter for you and your dogs (E-z Up tent, crate & X-pen).

Trial runs Rain or shine

PARKING: Limited parking will be available within the grounds of Willowbrae. Please use caution parking on Winston Churchill **only** south of the driveway toward the 80 km speed sign, on West side of the road and off the white line at edge of road. **NO TRUCK PARKING ON the grass,**

BITCHES IN SEASON (BIS): May compete at Barn Hunt trials, but will be required to be kept separate from all other dogs and **MUST** wear panties You *must* inform the trial secretary *prior* to the Trial that you are bringing a BIS. **Failure to do so is grounds for disqualification and dismissal.** Owners of BIS will crate/confine their dogs in the Club's designated area for BIS. Please re-read BH rules regarding BIS.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- All dogs must be **under control and on a short leash** while on trial grounds, except while competing.
- Use approved BHA collars. Dogs **MUST** run "naked" in the ring. PRONGS are allowed with quick detach and COVERED. See rules for specifics.
- Dog Aggression: Any dog behaving in a threatening or aggressive manner toward another dog or a person may be dismissed from the trial if justification is found to do so by the judge and/or trial committee. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- Loud/Disruptive dogs: Please keep barking to a minimum so as not to disturb working dogs and neighbours.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being ready to go into the blind area. The judge will not wait for any dog holding up a class/blind.
- Exhibitors and spectators are required to respect all signs posted on the property.
- Please stay out of the farm fields. Exhibitors and spectators are also reminded these trials are being held on private property and we are here at the pleasure of our hosts.
- Children need to be under strict supervision at all times. Out of respect for our competitors, if their behaviour is disruptive, you will be asked to leave the property.
- The Terra Cotta River Rats Club will use care and diligence for the safety and welfare of the dogs, the exhibitors, the spectators and the quarry, but will not be responsible in the event of any accident to dogs, exhibitors, spectators or quarry.
- **The use of illegal drugs, and/or alcohol, and/or smoking/vaping of any kind including legal marijuana, is not permitted anywhere on the property.**

Flexi leashes are not permitted anywhere on the property.

Please pick up after your dog(s) and yourself.
