There will be a short lunch break at the judges' discretion. Trial 2 will follow Trial 1. Moveups will be possible between Saturday and Sunday but not between trials on the same day.

The trial OPENS July 15. There will be a Random Draw from entries received by August 1. If the trials have not filled by then entries will be accepted as received until the limits are reached or until  
**August 24, 2013 at 6:00 p.m.**

Entry fees are \$15 for Novice Class and \$10 for Instinct Test.



Dogs may enter both the Instinct Test and Novice class in the same trial *until the dog has earned the RATN title and then they cannot enter the Instinct Test*. Dogs completing the RATN in the morning trial on Sunday may be moved up to Open for the second trial. This is up to the handler and not required. Move-ups will be accepted on Sunday up until ½ hour after the conclusion of Trial 1. Move-up forms will be available at the Secretary's table. All entries must be accompanied by entry fees to be valid. A returned check does not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$50 fee for all returned checks. No entries will be taken over the phone or electronically. Make check payable to CCSC. Send entries & fees to the trial secretary. Dogs must have a Barn Hunt registration number.

### DIRECTIONS TO TRIAL SITE

From East or West: take I-70 to Exit 131 St. Charles Rd/Lake of the Woods Rd. Turn S onto St. Charles Rd (0.1 mile). Turn R onto I-70 Drive SE. Stay on I-70 Drive SE for 0.9 mile. CCSC is on the left.

From North or South: take highway 63 to the I-70 interchange. Merge onto I-70 East and drive to Exit 131 St. Charles Rd/Lake of the Woods Rd. Turn S onto St. Charles Rd (0.1 mile). Turn R onto I-70 Drive SE. Stay on I-70 Drive SE for 0.9 mile. CCSC is on the left.

## EXHIBITOR INFORMATION

All dogs must be on a short leash and under control while on trial grounds except while showing. **FLEXI LEASHES ARE NOT PERMITTED INSIDE ANY BUILDINGS.** There is **NO SMOKING** in this facility or on the grounds. If you must smoke you will need to do so inside your vehicle and dispose of the butts in the vehicle also (this is a City Ordinance). Please pick up after your dog and dispose of waste in appropriate containers outside the building.



### RUNNING ORDER:

Dogs will be run in height order with dogs being handled by the same person separated into different staged groups.



**AWARDS:** Ribbons will be awarded for all qualifiers in the regular classes and the Instinct test. Rosettes will be awarded for first through fourth place in Novice through Master.



Please bring weather appropriate gear. These trials will be held indoors but the facility is affected by the outside temperature. There will be crating space available inside the building but please make sure your crate is secure as the dogs may be highly excited.



**Bitches in season are eligible for entry but will be required to be kept separate from all other dogs and will be run at the end of their class/trial.** Entry fees for bitches that come into season will be refunded until closing time of the trial if you wish to withdraw. After the trial closes, entry fees will not be refunded. If bringing a bitch in season, please inform the trial secretary prior to the trial and inform all exhibitors at the judge's briefing.



Please bring adequate water for you and your dogs. There will be a limited concession available on site and there are also numerous fast food restaurants within 5-10 minutes of the trial. There are indoor restrooms at the site.
