

Judging Assignment Cheat Sheet

60 days ahead you receive:

- ☐ Written/signed contract
- ☐ Class assignments.
- ☐ Grounds and Ring descriptions (footing, gating, etc.)
- ☐ Number, type, dimensions of ramps/steps and boards.
- ☐ Blind locations and distances in relation to the ring.
- ☐ Measurement/number of bales per course

30 days ahead you receive:

- ☐ Class order

10 days ahead you receive:

- ☐ Number of pre-entries received for each Class
- ☐ MRV for each class (so far)
- ☐ Current Load Balancing/Relief judging plans if any.

Course Mapping

Required

- ☐ **Title:** Name, Club Name, Date, Class Name & Trial #
- ☐ Key/Legend with all required elements (see rules)
- ☐ Numbered grid
- ☐ Entry gate location
- ☐ Whether the outer perimeter is fencing, wall, or combo
- ☐ Any obstructions in the ring
- ☐ Any dead areas (Instinct-Open)
- ☐ Anchor bales for freestanding tunnel structures
- ☐ Leaner bales marked with an arrow showing direction
- ☐ Tunnel Length (in key or on tunnel base layer)
- ☐ Location of board ends for tunnel
- ☐ **Bales:** Number on base level, total number, number being added or subtracted for nested courses
- ☐ Start box
- ☐ Base layer for course builders (see rules)
- ☐ Maps premarked for S/M/CZ8s (encouraged for all)

Suggested

- ☐ Rat Wrangler locations
- ☐ Judge Path

Not allowed

- ☐ Scribing box
- ☐ Fluff
